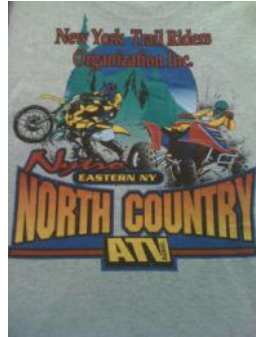

The members voted to allow the trail committee to spend up to 10,000. On equipment. The committee is looking to purchase a skid steer. If you know of one that is for sale please let one of the committee members

know. Moak will be contacting the insurance company to see if we need to have a rider added to the policy to cover the equipment.

Voted not to rejoin NYSOHVA at this time. We do not need the insurance they offer, there is no real benefit we would see for the price. They require \$5 per single membership and \$10. Per family membership, \$3.50 of that goes to their insurance.

Harold has offered to continue to plow the driveway and parking lot. The club has given him a free family membership and will reimburse him for his gas. He will give a gas receipt to Joe to turn in for payment. With the purchase of the equipment next year the club will be able to plow.

Storage trailer has been purchased and will remain where it is until we can get it moved to the property. Mike and Jim have been going over to shovel the roof. Moak, Mike and Jim will be going over to put supports in to help with the snow weight.

Large number turn out to support ATV trail development

NY Trail Riders Organization of Western New York (NYTRO Western NY) and Wyoming County Tourism sponsored an informational meeting at the Gainesville Fire Hall on Sunday, January 30th. The meeting focused on the feasibility of a county and region wide wheeled vehicle trail network and was open to all ATV riders, UTV riders, dirt bike riders and all off road enthusiasts. Over 100 were present for the meeting, which drew attendance from Erie, Niagara, Genesee, Allegany and Wyoming County.

Guest presenters included Jeff Binga, President of New York State Off Road Vehicle Association; Brian Fleischman, Director of Wyoming County Tourism; Joanna Wemes, President of New York Trail Riders Organization, Russ Meidenbauer, Vice President of NYTRO Western NY and Gary Hume, Trail Coordinator of NYTRO Western NY.

Meidenbauer and Hume provided the group with an update of the status of the proposed Silver Springs Multi-Use Trail System that

could provide riders access to a 35-mile abandoned rail bed that runs from Silver Springs to Machias Junction in Cattaraugus County. The Genesee & Wyoming Railroad, which currently has rights to the railway, is reviewing the proposal for consideration. Hume indicated, "We have been asked by Genesee & Wyoming Railroad Management to resubmit our request for use which would appear to be a positive sign. This is one of the first steps we need to take to gain legal access to the rail bed between the months of April and October."

Brian Fleischman, Wyoming County Director of Tourism commented, "Wyoming County Tourism is in support of developing a safe and responsible county and region wide ATV trail network that doesn't interfere with agricultural land use. I envision a network that links our lodging and campgrounds to local attractions

and retail businesses, which would provide a memorable riding experience and bring visitors back multiple times throughout the year. Currently our county loses tens of millions of dollars annually of potential visitor spending as a result of not having legalized ATV trails. The economic impact of ATV use in Lewis County (NY) alone totals over \$33 million annually. Even more surprising, Erie County (NY), which borders Wyoming County, has the highest number of registered ATV owners in New York and they have nowhere to ride so they bypass Wyoming County to go to Pennsylvania and the Adirondack Region of New York where fully developed trail networks exist."

Fleischman and the others hope that their efforts will lead to the development of a local and regional trail network that could provide economic benefits to Wyoming County indefinitely into the future. Studies have

shown that organized ATV trail networks significantly decrease unlawful property damage as it creates an outlet for ATV owners to ride that protects the private landowners through insurance funds similar to those used by the snowmobile federations. Research also proves that local businesses and local communities stand to benefit the most from ATV trails and related visitor spending. This would reach all segments of retail such as gas, food & beverage, lodging, service and equipment & apparel sales. Jobs, business growth and increased sales tax revenue would all be measurable benefits by developing a trail network.

The group plans to meet again in February and is in the process of developing an ATV riding event that will be hosted in Wyoming County in late spring. For details or comments, please contact Wyoming County Tourism at 585-237-0230.

**UPDATE: Kids Just Want to Ride Act, .R. 412, Introduced!
Contact your Representative to Cosponsor Today!**

Take Action!

On Jan. 25, Representative Denny Rehberg (MT) introduced .R. 412, the Kids Just Want to Ride Act of 2011, which would exempt kids' off-highway vehicles (OHVs) from the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act (CPSIA) of 2008 that effectively bans their sale beginning May 1. The American Motorcyclist Association (AMA) strongly supports this bipartisan effort and is urging everyone to contact their Representative to become a cosponsor today.

H.R. 412 is the most promising and viable legislative remedy available to permanently exclude kid-sized motorcycles and ATVs from the unintended consequences of the CPSIA.

The AMA thanks the countless concerned enthusiasts that have already contacted their Representatives to support this legislation. However, we are facing a fast-approaching May 1 stay of enforcement deadline and you must continue to contact your member of Congress to help the Kids Just Want to Ride Act of 2011 move toward passage.

You and everyone you know that is concerned with the future of youth riding needs to contact your Representative and ask them to cosponsor H.R. 412, the Kids Just Want to Ride Act of 2011. You can write your member of Congress by following the "Take Action" option and sending a letter directly to their office in Washington, DC. You can also call your Representative. Tell your Representative to cosponsor H.R. 412, the Kids Just Want to Ride Act of 2011 immediately.
