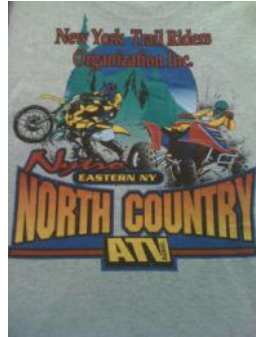

Pennsylvania State Lands Trails

Where to ride? That's the constant question. Unfortunately we live in a state that is totally blind to the recreational and economic value of all terrain vehicles. The result is virtually no place to ride on New York State land despite the fact that we pay taxes that allow purchase and management of that land for other kinds of recreation. And the only way this is ever going to change is to keep pressure on Albany through the media, contact with government, and the ballot box.

But fortunately we live adjacent to a state that understands the worth of ATV trails and provides them for use free of charge. That's right, free. As in no charge to ride.

I'm talking about Pennsylvania, where ATVs are accorded a measure of respect that is completely lacking in New York. Not only that, but your New York State ATV registration and insurance are accepted in Pennsylvania, too. Unlike private ride parks, you don't have to re-register or buy a trail permit or join a club or anything to ride the Keystone state trails. Of course, our southern neighbors are very pleased when visitors spend money with local businesses for things like gas, lodging, food, souvenirs, and so forth.

Over the past few seasons I have been exploring Pennsylvania state lands ATV trails with my Keystone State riding buddies Harrison and Craig, and we have found them to be quite diverse and a lot of fun to ride. Managed by the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR), they are open from the Friday before Memorial Day through the last full weekend of September. And note that Pennsylvania also offers a winter riding season for some trail complexes. That runs from the end of deer season until the first of April.

All offer designated trail heads with parking areas, many of which include ramps for pick-up trucks. All are mapped, and trail maps are available at some trail heads until the supply is depleted, but they are generally available from the regional DCNR offices. Trail marking varies greatly. Some trails are graded by difficulty using the standard green (easy), blue (intermediate) and black (expert only) color code. And watch for animals. We've seen all sorts of interesting wildlife while riding these areas.

Unless otherwise noted, these trails are open to ATVs ONLY. No two wheelers of any kind and no UTVs, jeeps, or trucks allowed, either.

Here's a short description of just some of the quality riding that is available if you are willing to drive a few hours south.

Denton Hill / Susquehannock State Forest. Located on super-scenic US Route 6 just east of Coudersport in Potter County, the Susquehannock State Forest offers about 43 miles of summer trails for ATVs only. Situated on the south side of Denton Hill, these relatively smooth trails are well-mapped and well-marked to provide easy riding and include rest rooms on the trail in Lyman Run State Park, so they are very suitable for beginners, families, and group trips. However, they are very popular on weekends and jam packed on the big holiday weekends, so the best time to visit is during the week. Potato City Country Inn and the Potter County Family Campground provide quality lodging directly adjacent to the trails and other services including several dealerships are available in the area. And a word to the wise, bear-proof everything because black bears are very bold in this area.

Whiskey Springs / Sproul State Forest. Located west of Renovo on State Route 120 in Clinton County, Whiskey Springs offers 45 miles of trails for use in both summer and winter ATV seasons. This is a mined-out area that offers some awesome mountaintop views of the pre-glacial terrain, plus numerous slag heaps to play on and around. Some of the area is still lacking any vegetation, some has been recently recovered, and some is forested or open field. The mountain laurel blooms in late June making this the best time to visit. Riding is pretty easy for the most part, but signage could be better, and there are places where you definitely don't want to make a mistake, especially since it's a pretty remote area with no services of any kind. However, there are 14 camping sites available with permits required from the DCNR office in Shintown, just west of Renovo. The camping area includes rest rooms and picnic tables, and tends to be packed on weekends but deserted during the week. A special handicapped parking area is also available. And if you're going through Renovo, we suggest you stop at Yesterday's restaurant. The food's good and the classic rock and roll atmosphere is even better.

Riding PA—Continued

Bloody Skillet / Sproul State Forest. Located mostly in Centre County, Bloody Skillet is the most remote ATV area in the entire Keystone State. There simply isn't much of anything anywhere near it. North end access is off State Route 144 roughly 20 miles south of Renovo, and south end access is via the Village of Orviston off State Route 1016 to the west of Lock Haven. Harrison and I think this might be the best of all of the Keystone state riding areas, offering a nice mix of very easy to seriously demanding riding that includes steep hills, side-hilling, lots of rocks in places, a very refreshing creek ford that can be more difficult than it first appears, and some superb scenic views. Bloody Skillet currently has almost 40 miles of summer season trails, and overnight camping is allowed with a permit available on weekdays from the DCNR office in Shintown, near Renovo. But there are no services of any kind once you leave the trail head parking lot, or anywhere else in the area, so you are really on your own out there. Go prepared for anything.

Haneyville / Tiadaghton State Forest. Hidden deep in the North Central Mountains north of Lock Haven, Haneyville is a little-known gem accessible from State Route 44. Open in both summer and winter seasons, the 18 miles of trail range from very easy to some fairly difficult riding with occasional sharp off-camber turns, some side-hilling, and some rather steep slopes. Some of these trails were actually constructed by the Civilian Conservation Corps in the 1930's. At one point there's a great view of the massive Pine Creek Gorge, also known as Pennsylvania's Grand Canyon. Limited services are available in the general area at places like McConnell's Country Store in Waterville and Fin, Fur, & Feather in Haneyville, but the closest lodging is in Lock Haven. Direct access from the north is rather difficult due to very poor quality roads heading south through the mountains.

Sideling Hill / Buchanan State Forest. Located in Fulton County down near the Maryland state line, Sideling Hill is a delightful little area with about 15 miles of summer trails near Wells Tannery. The riding area is accessible via side roads off State Route 915, but you need good directions, a good GPS, or a good map to find your way in here. The trails are generally easy riding and not confusing at all, so it's a good place for beginners and families. And it's also not far from Breezewood where gas, food, and lodging are readily available, much of it from national chain vendors.

Martin Hill / Buchanan State Forest. Located even closer to Maryland on Route 326 a bit south of Rainsburg in Bedford County, Martin Hill offers just plain difficult, physically demanding riding. The area offers 18 miles of summer trails that are rocky and rough with short steep slopes and a lot of off-camber sections, so it is suitable only for those with advanced riding skills. Forget taking a sport quad here. It's one place where you really want four-wheel drive and lots of ground clearance. Mature trees and bushes in most places block out most scenic views, so Martin Hill is really all about the tough trails. If you want to test your riding skills, this is a good place to go. And it's out in the middle of nowhere, so come prepared.

There are five other Keystone state trail areas that I haven't visited yet, including **Michaux State Forest** in Adams and Cumberland Counties of south central Pennsylvania. My buddy Harrison rides this area frequently and says it is very rocky, technical riding that he enjoys, so it's definitely not for the throttle-down sport quad crowd.

And we should note that Pennsylvania also offers many other ATV riding opportunities. The Allegheny National Forest has four distinct trail areas scattered across federal lands in four counties of northwest PA. A modestly priced permit is now required to ride these trails.

Many more miles of quad trails are located on private lands or joint public/private areas, typically with fees or membership requirements to ride. Among them are Majestic Trails, Rock Run, Mines and Meadows, and the Snow Show Rail Trail (SSRT). Information on all these can be found on line. My article about the rather unique SSRT will run in *ATV magazine* later this season.

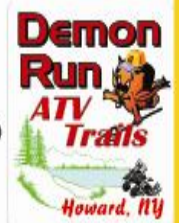
